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## EMT 1, 2 & 3 Instructor Course

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### 2nd Week Course Prerequisites:

- Copy of current Alaska certification as an EMT-1, 2, 3, or MICP; or certification as a EMT-Basic, EMT-Intermediate, or Paramedic by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians, or authorization to practice in the state as a Physician, Physician Assistant, or Registered Nurse.
- Evidence of at least three years experience as an EMT or Paramedic, (State of Alaska MICP's are exempt for this requirement).
- Evidence of successful completion of the State of Alaska practical exam for EMT-1, 2, 3; or practical exam for EMT-Basic, EMT-Intermediate, or EMT-Paramedic by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians within the last 12 months before attending the course.
- Copy of documentation indicating a score of 90% or above on appropriate Alaska EMT exam within two attempts within the last 12 months, but no later than **December 12, 2011**.
- Individuals who have previously taken a 40-hour MOI course do not need to attend the first week of the course. Please provide documentation of previous course completion.

*All required documentation along with full payment must be received at the IREMSC Office by December 12, 2011 to guarantee acceptance into the course.*

*Sorry, cancellations on or after December 12, 2011 will not be refunded or credited.*

Class size is limited to 10 students. Priority enrollment will be given to individuals from areas that are currently without EMT instructor resources. Additional selection criteria may include pre-hospital experience, level of training, need for additional instructors in your area, examination scores, and the date the required documentation is received by the IREMSC Office.

The Methods of Instruction (MOI) course will cover aspects of adult education and the learning environment, as well as regulations governing the teaching of EMTs in the State of Alaska. This course is designed to be an intensive learning experience and may require completion of homework at night and on weekends. It is expected that you are proficient with EMT skills and knowledge prior to entering this training program as there will be no review of EMT skills or knowledge during this class.

**EMT Instructor Course Applicants**

- A copy of your valid EMT-I, EMT-II, or EMT-III certification, a paramedic license, or certification as a paramedic by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians.
- Verification that you have been, for at least three years, a certified or licensed active emergency medical services responder.
- Evidence of having taken the State of Alaska EMT practical exam within the last 12 months.

**Important Notice**

This form must be completed and provided to the course coordinator in sufficient time for it to be sent and received at the Community Health and Emergency Medical Services Section, in Juneau. You are strongly recommended to take the examination, and necessary retests, as far in advance of first day of the instructor course as is permissible and no later than 10 working days before the first day of the course. You will be denied entrance into the class if you have not passed the examination in accordance with the requirements set forth in the regulations.
